

Terms of Use for NXP's DocStore Portal. Version 1.1 – March 2013

Unless your use of NXP's DocStore Portal ("Portal") is subject to a separate, signed agreement between you and NXP, your use of the Portal is governed by the below terms of use ("Terms of Use").

Acceptance of Terms of Use

By accessing and using the Portal you agree to be bound by the following Terms of Use, and all terms and conditions contained and/or referenced herein, and all such terms shall be deemed accepted by you. If you do NOT agree to all these terms, you may NOT use this Portal. If you do not agree to any additional specific terms which apply to particular Content (as defined below) or to particular transactions concluded through this Web Site, then you may NOT use the part of the Portal which contains such Content or through which such transactions may be concluded and you may not use such Content or conclude such transactions.

These Terms of Use may be amended by NXP at any time. Such amended Terms of Use shall be effective upon posting on this Portal at <https://www.docstore.nxp.com>. Your continued use of the Portal following the posting of such amended Terms of Use will constitute your acceptance of such amended Terms of Use.

Other NXP web sites may have their own terms of use which apply to such web sites. Such specific terms may be in different than these Terms of Use.

NXP reserves the right to make changes or updates with respect to or in the Content of the Portal or the format thereof at any time without notice. NXP reserves the right to terminate or restrict access to the Portal for any reason whatsoever at its sole discretion.

Access to Portal and technical security conditions

Access to the Portal will only be granted upon your subscription at <https://www.docstore.nxp.com>. It is within NXP's reasonable discretion, to allow or deny access to the Portal. Once NXP has granted access to the Portal, you will be assigned a password that is for you own exclusive, personal use of the Portal. You must keep the password confidential and secure and it is strictly prohibited to share it with anyone else. NXP personnel will never ask for your password.

NXP reserves the right to temporarily or permanently deny or restrict your access to the Portal, particularly in the case you have breached these Terms of Use.

If you are asked to choose a password, you must choose a unique one for the Portal which you do not use for other purposes.

NXP will provide you with a certificate including a private key which will be protected by a password (in the following referred to as "Certificate") provided to you by NXP. This Certificate and the password are for your exclusive personal use only and it is strictly prohibited to share them with anyone else within or outside your company, including your working team or business unit.

If you have reason to believe that your account details have become known to anyone else, you must immediately inform NXP at the address support.docstore@nxp.com.

You are not allowed to remove the password and to store outside the keystore of the operating system or of the Adobe Reader or other Adobe software the Certificate without being protected by the password provided to you by NXP.

You are only allowed to install the Certificate on a PC that is under the responsibility of the legal entity which also concluded the NDA (as defined below).

If the PC is also used by other people in your company, you must make sure that such other people will not have access to any of the Content provided to you, and that the other people cannot / will not export the Certificate.

It is your obligation and responsibility to make a proper backup of the Certificate that protects it, since it will be needed again when you e.g. use a new or different PC to access the Portal. You must make sure that no one else will be able to get access to this backup information.

All communication with the Portal will use a protected SSL connection. For all use of the Portal, you must verify that the browser indicates that an HTTPS session is running, and that the address is docstore.nxp.com. If the browser indicates that a certificate is not valid, you must not continue using the Portal or the Web Site, since an attack may have taken place.

You are responsible for equipping your PC with up-to-date virus software and firewalls.

NXP recommends that you protect your data by fully encrypting your hard disk, using software like TrueCrypt or BitLocker.

Download and Use of Content

Access to the Content is only granted after you have concluded an NDA with NXP that governs disclosure of Content from NXP to you ("NDA"). After you have registered you will receive an NDA for signing if your company does not have an applicable NDA in effect. There is a manual process at the side of NXP

involved for this. Any use of the Content must strictly conform to these Terms of Use as well as the NDA.

NXP reserves the right to watermark the Content provided to you with your personal name, company name and other information for protection purposes. It is strictly prohibited to reverse engineer the Content protection measures or to rescind or suspend in any other way the watermarking of the Content.

It is strictly forbidden to share your personal copy of the Content which is watermarked with your name, nor the information that forms the Content with anyone else, including any third party in your company, business unit or working team. It is recommended that anyone in your company needing the Content obtains an own personal copy.

Documents which are classified as Company Public can be shared within your company without restrictions.

For reasons of export control, you are only allowed to download Content while being in the same country as that one which was specified for your company during registration to DocStore.

The Content may be provided as PDF, Flash or a zip file packed in a PDF file. You are not allowed to access those files via tools other than by using genuine Adobe software.

Content packed in zip files are allowed to be exported from the zip file. When such files are PDF or Flash files, the same restrictions above hold as for PDF or Flash documents which are not packed in a zip file.
